

6 Night, 7 Day trip for 2 in Belize at Cotton Tree Lodge

Step into the world of the Maya and explore untouched rivers and jungles for a once in a lifetime experience. Tour the rainforest and awaken your senses to the sounds of exotic birds and wildlife. Rope swing from trees along the Moho River or paddle upstream in a wooden dugout canoe or kayak. Fish the Salt Flats for giant permit or immerse yourself in the Remote Jungle rivers casting for snook, tubas, and tarpon. Go horseback riding in the jungle or maybe visit the many Mayan ruins in the area. Take a 30 foot jump from a waterfall in the morning and make your own chocolate bars in the afternoon. Visit the small town of Punta Gorda on Market day and see the vast array of local fruits, vegetables and fish. The lodge is totally off the grid, using mainly solar power. They raise fresh crops, harvest local wild fruits, and even tend their own flocks of chicken, goats and cattle. Your cabanas are nested 16 feet above the ground and perched along the slow moving Moho River. After you have enjoyed an evening gourmet meal prepared by our chef fall asleep to the sounds of the howler monkeys and the sound of the jungle. This and more awaits you.

Sample itinerary:

Day 1 arrival to lodge by overland or boat–afternoon of leisure, explore the vast 100 acre grounds–take a fling on the “made in heaven” tree swing into the Moho river till you tire, sunset kayak ride with a Belizean rum punch, Gourmet dinner and sleep with the sounds only the rain forest can provide

Day 2 Explore the remote Lubaantun Ruins–site of the famed Crystal skull in the morning–lunch at Rio Blanco Waterfall–Take the 30 leap from the falls into the deep pool below–Sundowners at the bar

Day 3 A full day of fishing in the Jungle Rivers and salt flats of southern Belize–Lunch on board the boat or pull up on a remote caye for swimming and playing in the sand. If you have the energy, you can enjoy a Night hike.

Day 4 Excited to report Day 4.

Day 5 After a hearty hot breakfast spend the morning on an animated and delicious guided walk on a working cacao farm. Spend lunch at your guide’s home and prepare traditional “Hot Chocolate”– return to your cabana for an afternoon nap–Fresh Fish you caught on the menu tonight.

Day 6 A day full of adventure–start with a jungle horseback ride and then off to the Blue Creek cave. Your guide will escort you thru crystal blue water nearly ¼ mile into the side of a Belizean Mountain equipped with headlamps to discover a beautiful waterfall. Afternoon swim and swing–Sundowners–Dinner– does it have to end

Day 7 Farwell Breakfast of Black beans– Fresh eggs–fruit you picked and sausages. Prepare for trip back to the grass runway for tropic air flight to BZE and then home.

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
