



5 hunting days/nights for 1 hunter and 1 observer.

Kalahari area on the border with the Free State Province and the Northern Cape.

Hunters must fly to Johannesburg, sleep over for the night and take a morning flight to Kimberley. 1 hour 50 min flight.

Closest airport : Kimberley, with 3 daily flights from Johannesburg.

Hunt area : Bonnievale Game Reserve, 15 miles from Kimberley airport. Very well managed hunt concession.

Typical Kalahari bushveld with open savanna and hills. Deep red sand with scattered bush and grassland.

Over 24 species of plains game, including lion and Cape buffalo. Thousands of head of game. Low hunting pressure.

This hunt is for rifle or bow hunting. Rated very high for the serious bowhunter.

Rifles like a .300 Win Mag does well here. Reference Fred Kaminski.

Albert will be at the EXPO.

Donation includes:

Meet and greet at Kimberley airport - arrival and departure.

Personal PH with camp staff, including sjef and skinners.

All transport on hunt area with 4 x 4 hunting vehicle during hunt.

Skinning and field dressing and salting of trophies, by experienced staff.

The following trophy animals is included :

- 1) Kalahari Gemsbok.
- 2) Red Hartebeest.
- 3) South African Springbok.

Hunter can expect to harvest great animals. Hunter can add more game and hunting days, as per price list of 2012 season.

Hunter can bring 3 more hunting partners if he wants.

Extra hunters must pay normal day and trophy fees as on 2012 price list.

Donation excludes : Taxidermy costs, transportation of trophies to taxidermist (\$ 450). Tips to PH and staff. Wines, alcoholic beverages and other personal expenses.
