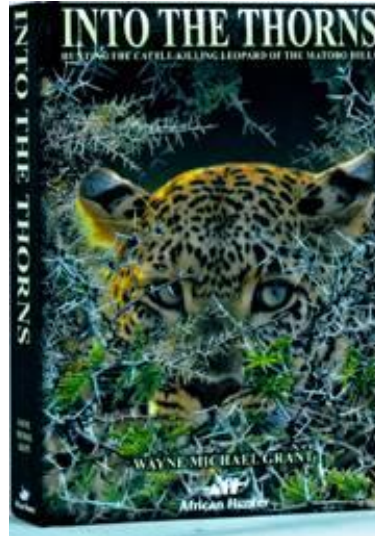


INTO THE THORNS

Published by African Hunter Magazine...they really know their stuff and so does the author. If you're seeking a really good book about leopard hunting, and a currently issued one authored by a respected professional hunter, then Wayne Grant's INTO THE THORNS is for you. Wayne has garnered many hunting awards, including Professional Hunter of the Year and he's still a very active PH in Zimbabwe. He has plenty of dangerous game experience and he writes well. In sum, this book is well produced, well written by a man of experience and it's a book we're proud to recommend.

Although his love affair with the African wilds began in the 1960s, Wayne Grant started professional hunting at the end of the war in Rhodesia (1980) and in 1985 he started his own safari company. Since that time he has enjoyed both living in Africa's wild places and taking clients on safari. Leopard hunting is his specialty. The stories recounted in the book show Grant's understanding of the African leopard and his hunting ability. The leopard is a survivor and when given a chance it repopulates rehabilitated game lands very quickly. But he must be given a chance and hunted fairly so that the trails that wind through the ancient kopjes will continue to show his tracks and the brooding cliffs and valleys will continue to echo with the sounds
