

Sun Africa Safaris -7 Days 6 Animals included. Two Hunters



Pierre and Annalie Moolman have once again stepped up with a 100% donation for two hunters. This is a 7 day safari that includes all meals, lodging, 2x1 Professional Hunter guiding, trackers, skinners and all field game care and trophy prep. Point of arrival is Port Elizabeth, South Africa, reached through Johannesburg or Cape Town. Pick up and return, PE-lodge-PE is \$200 per vehicle. This is a rifle hunt with .270 Winchester and larger recommended depending on species hunted. The safari **includes six game species listed in the SCI Record Book, 1 each shared by hunters, common springbuck, black springbuck, white springbuck, steenbuck, common bush duiker, and an ostrich.** 60 rounds of ammunition is suggested, limit is 200 rounds.

Non-hunting guests are \$200 per day per person. Additional hunters \$400 per day. Your hunting friends are welcome to join you. Sample 2010 trophy fees. Cape

PH good at evaluating the quality of animals and letting you know what their evaluation was, but the final decision was yours.

Hunting areas very immense, diversified and beautiful. I had the opportunity to take a Bleesbuck, Mountain Reedbuck, Duiker, Gemsbuck, Warthog, Common Springbok, White Springbok, Black Springbok, Impala and Ostrich. Each hunt unique to the animal and terrain.

My wife Ellen is a non hunter but went on the 1st hunt for Bleesbuck. She enjoyed so much she went on all hunts after that 1st one. She was scared to sit up on the spotting seat that 1st hunt but you couldn't get out of that seat after that no matter the terrain as she wanted to experience all that was going on.

I do highly recommend a Safari with Sun Africa and hopefully my wife and I will be able to visit our South African family in the future.
